

Potential Credit Opportunities

The following scenarios represent potential structures for credit opportunities with a school/university. Each academic institution has the ultimate decision on how to structure the requirements for credit, and how these credits may be transferred, as Disney Internships & Programs does not award or transfer credits.

Scenario #1

Requirement:

- Complete one [Harvard ManageMentor](#) topic including the following:
 - Answer the reflection questions for each of the videos & articles
 - Write a summary/essay of the topic reflecting on how it related to their program experience (living, learning, and earning).
- Successfully complete their program to meet ACE credit recommendation*

Reflection Questions for Videos & Articles:

1. Discuss a section that you had a positive reaction to within the video/article. Should be at least 3-5 sentences and reference the page/section.
2. A negative reaction to the video/article (at least 3-5 sentences). Discuss a section you did not like and why, and reference the page/section.
3. Ideas: What can you do (based on the videos/articles) to help in your personal or professional development (at least 1-3 ideas).

Scenario #2

Requirement:

- Complete one [Harvard ManageMentor](#) module on a leadership topic
- Interview 1-2 salaried leaders in their work location regarding the HMM topic
- Write a comprehensive paper including:
 - Compare/contrast what they learned in the HMM module and what they heard from the leaders.
 - Why might the leaders answers be different to what they learned in the modules?
 - How does what they learned from the interviews & HMM module relate to your overall internship experience?
- Successfully complete their program to meet ACE credit recommendation*

Scenario #3

Requirement:

- Complete a minimum of 10 hours of course offerings (any mix of what is available – Exploring Disney, Career Connection etc. Does not have to be a series-based course, and could be a combination of offerings that total 10 hours. (details for courses available and course lengths can be found at <https://dorms.disney.com/learning>).
- Write an extensive essay on how the offerings they choose to attend related to their program experience, and what they learned
 - Must detail out each offering they completed and key information they learned from each offering
 - Must include how the offering related to their program experience
- Successfully complete their program to meet ACE credit recommendation*
